

## **RESOLUTION NO. R-2018-**

**A RESOLUTION** authorizing a Yakima Economic Development Marketing Agreement with the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of Yakima for the annual Cinco De Mayo Festival.

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to contract with the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of Yakima for the promotion and marketing of economic and business development and tourism activities, opportunities and programs within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of Yakima is a nonprofit corporation with charitable tax exempt status under Internal Revenue Code §501(c) (3), with offices located at 22 S. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Yakima, Washington 98902, whose primary purpose is to promote business development and provide economic opportunities for Hispanic businesses and community development in neighborhoods within the City of Yakima; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties agree that the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of Yakima will administer the funds and activities described in the three-year Yakima Economic Development Marketing Agreement, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, providing funding for the Chamber's annual Cinco De Mayo Festival in the amount of \$20,000 in 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, after successful completion of the annual Action Plan for each of the succeeding two years the City will consider providing funding for the 2019 and 2020 contract terms and any amounts awarded for each of these two subsequent years will be less than the funding provided the prior year and will be based on funding availability; and

**WHEREAS**, after the 2020 contract year the City will provide no additional funding to produce the Cinco De Mayo Festival; Now, Therefore,

### **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:**

The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached and incorporated three year Yakima Economic Development Marketing Agreement with the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of Yakima to promote economic development, business activities and tourism within the City in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement supporting the Chamber's annual Cinco De Mayo Festival.
