

RESOLUTION NO. R-2019-

A RESOLUTION authorizing an agreement with Counsilman-Hunsaker to conduct a feasibility study for construction of an outdoor pool at Martin Luther King Jr. Park.

WHEREAS, the City is the owner of Martin Luther King Jr. Park located at S. 9th St. & E. Race St., Yakima, Washington, situated generally upon and within Yakima County Assessor's Parcel No. 19131941451; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to conduct a professional feasibility study to consider the construction of an outdoor pool at Martin Luther King Jr. Park; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified Counsilman-Hunsaker as a consultant that possesses the necessary expertise in swimming pool complex siting, planning and design; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to retain Counsilman-Hunsaker as its independent consultant for purposes of feasibility analysis and planning for a proposed outdoor pool at Martin Luther King Jr. Park; and

WHEREAS, the Scope of Work and Budget included in the Feasibility Study Agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference meet the needs and requirements of the City of Yakima for this project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to enter into the Feasibility Study Agreement with Counsilman-Hunsaker for consultation services related to conducting a feasibility study for the proposed Martin Luther King Jr. Park pool project; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute a Professional Services Agreement with Counsilman-Hunsaker, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, in an amount not to exceed Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) to provide the Professional Services described in the Agreement.
