Specific outcomes desired and measured

1. YPAL members will attend/have improved attendance at school.
2. YPAL members will have improved grades at school.
3. YPAL members will have improvement of any disciplinary issues at school.
4. YPAL members will have improvement of any disciplinary issues at home.

Before you joined YPAL, did you have issues with attendance?

Only two students reported issues with attendance at school.

Both students participate in Boxing.

One reported improvement with attendance and one reported no improvement. (50% improvement rate)

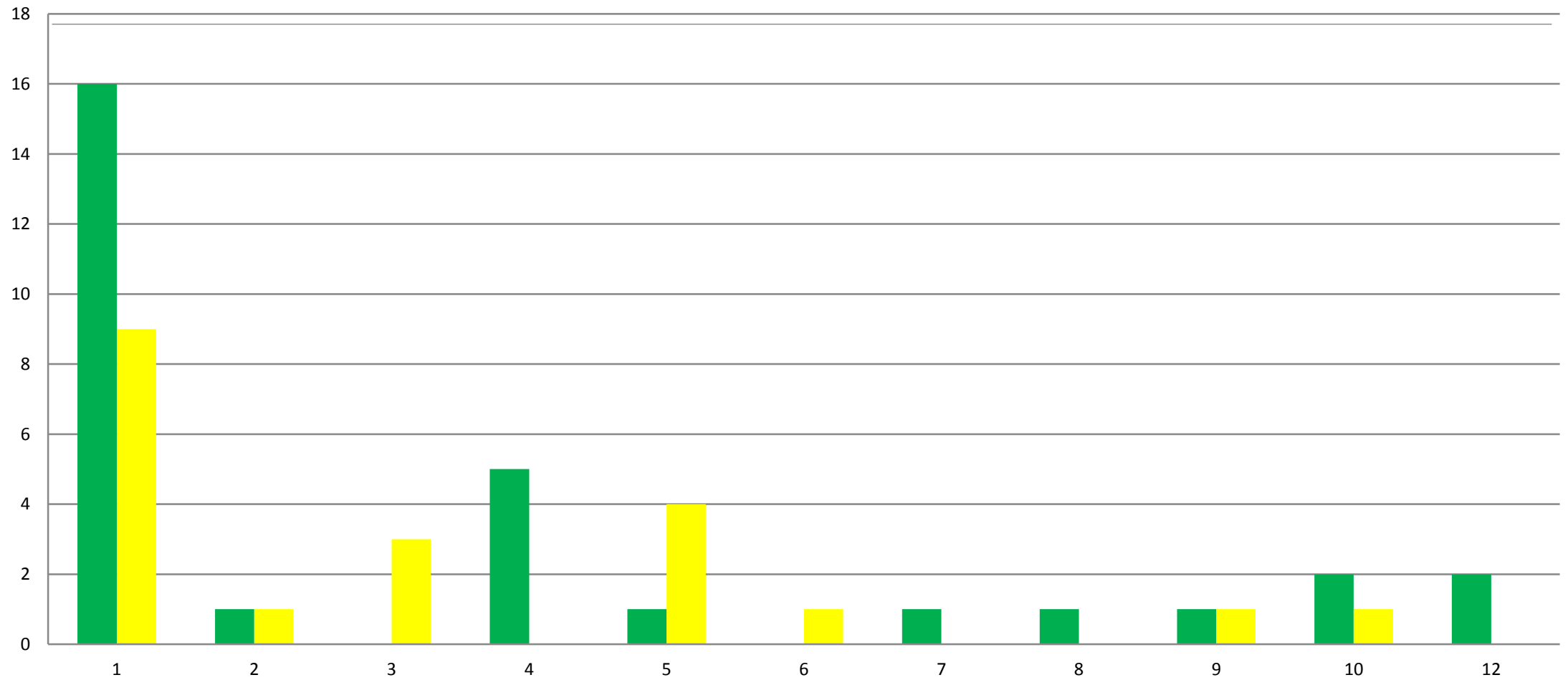
After joining YPAL, did your grades... (by number of activities attended)

60% of respondents reported that their grades improved after joining YPAL. This shows the number of activities students attended.

■ improve ■ remain unchanged



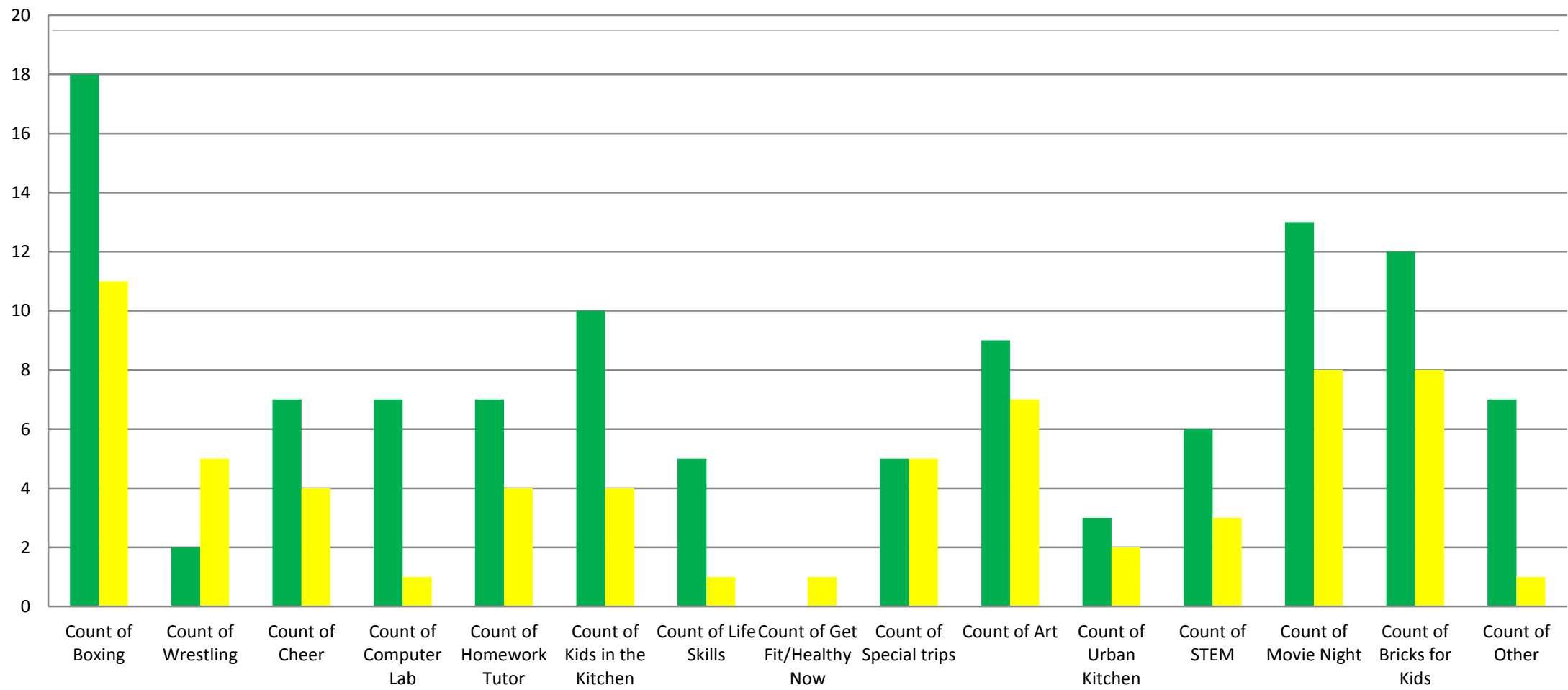
After Joining YPAL, did your grades... (by specific program)

This shows improvement according to which activity they attended. The numbers add up to more than the test sample of 50 because many students attended more than one activity. 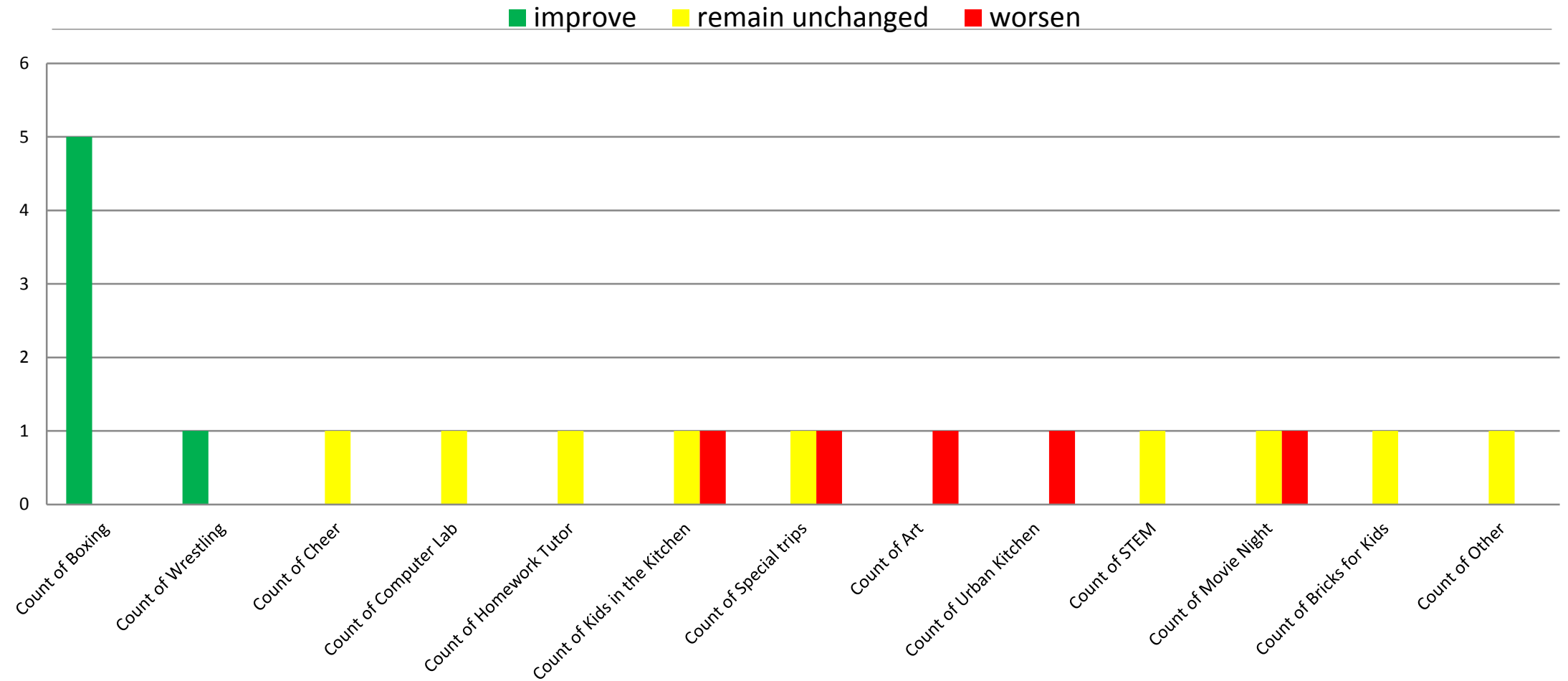


If you had discipline issues at school, after joining YPAL, did these issues...

There were a total of 8 students who reported discipline issues at school.

- One student whose discipline issues worsened participated in five activities (red bar).
- One student, who reported the issues remained unchanged, participates in 9 activities (yellow bar).
- The remaining six students reported improvement in their discipline issues.

If you had discipline issues at home, after joining YPAL, did these issues:

The total number of students who reported discipline issues at home was reported as 5.

- Only one student reported no improvement. This student participates in 10 activities.
- One student whose issues improved, participated in three activities; cheer, homework tutor, and bricks for kids.
- The remaining three children participated in one activity each (2 in boxing, one in wrestling)
