The Yakima City Council is pleased to provide this letter in support of La Casa Hogar's application for a Cities for Citizenship grant. La Casa Hogar's citizenship program has established itself as an extraordinary pathway to citizenship for more than 1,200 community members here in the Yakima Valley. In summer 2018, the Yakima City Council authorized the City of Yakima to become a member of Cities for Citizenship. - Support U.S. citizenship for eligible, lawful, permanent Yakima-area community members
- Utilize City communications platforms to share information about citizenship resources available in the Yakima area
- Annually proclaim New Citizens Day
- Encourage City staff and volunteers to participate in Cities for Citizenship training opportunities
- Regularly communicate with La Casa Hogar staff regarding the La Casa Hogar Citizenship Program and receive quarterly reports on its progress
