

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-_____

AN ORDINANCE relating to Public Safety; amending section 6.20.280 of the City of Yakima Municipal Code relating to control of dogs.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

Section 1. The following section, 6.20.280, of the City of Yakima Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.20.280 Barking dogs—disturbing the peace prohibited.

(1) It is unlawful for any person in control of premises to keep, harbor or maintain thereon any dog or dogs which individually or together disturb the peace and repose of any person(s) within the city of Yakima, by repeatedly or continuously barking, growling, yelping, howling, or whining for a duration of twenty minutes or more. A violation of this section is a civil infraction punishable by a \$250 fine.

(2) It shall be an affirmative defense to subsection (1) of this section that the howling, yelping, barking or other noise complained of was by a guard dog or watch dog which was responding to intruders, trespassers or other persons entering onto or near the premises of the dog owner.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect 30 days after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law and by the City Charter.
