A RESOLUTION authorizing a professional services contract for inmate health care services with Kite Med Consultants, LLC

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima requires professional services related to inmate health care services for the City of Yakima Detention Facility located at the Richard A. Zais, Jr. Center for Law and Justice, 200 South Third Street, Yakima, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City has contracted with Kite Med Consultants, LLC for inmate health care services since October 1, 2014 (City Contract No. 2014-173); and

WHEREAS, the City's current contract with Kite Med Consultants, LLC, for inmate health care services expires on September 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Linda Seaman is the CEO of Kite Med Consultants, LLC, and Kite Med Consultants, LLC represents that it has the expertise necessary and is willing to perform the professional services required by the City in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima and Kite Med Consultants, LLC desire to enter into a Professional Services Contract for inmate health care services for a three-year term, from October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2022, with an option to extend the Contract for one additional two-year period; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the best interest of the City to authorize the City Manager to execute a Professional Services Contract for inmate health care services with Kite Med Consultants, LLC; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute the attached professional services contract for inmate health care services with Kite Med Consultants, LLC.
