Human Resources Director Mendoza reported on the Interim City Manager search. It was Council consensus to add this as an executive session item on September 17, that staff prescreen the applications and reduce the number to be considered to eight, with a top four identified.

Interim City Manager Martinez reviewed the updated Strategic Plan and the study session schedule for the remainder of the year.
