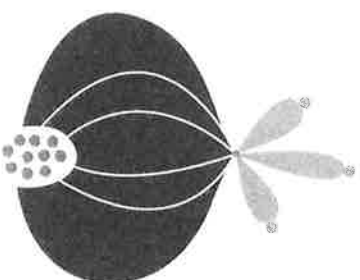

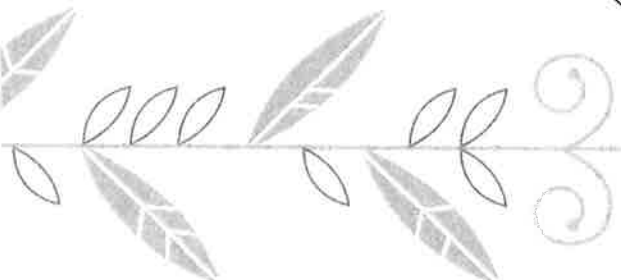
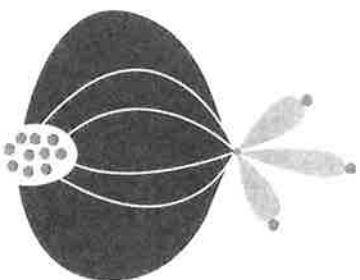
can't say enough good things about D.N.S. They
