WHEREAS, the Yakima Rotary Club's first community service project was to have proper street signs put up so people would not get lost in the city of Yakima; and on an annual basis continues through support of projects and programs that meet the needs of children's health, literacy, hunger, quality of life improvements to our parks and public spaces; and

WHEREAS, on an annual basis the Yakima Rotary Club awards \$87,000 in Vocational and Academic Scholarships to area students to fulfill their higher education goals; and

WHEREAS, service extends on a global level to partner with other Rotary clubs throughout the world to eradicate polio; and

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2019 the Yakima Rotary Club celebrates 100 years of Service above Self marking this monumental occasion with the opening of the YMCA Yakima Rotary Aquatic Center contributed by local Rotary Clubs and their members, and a new playground and picnic shelter at Martin Luther King, Jr. Park; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I Kathy Coffey, Mayor of the City of Yakima and on behalf of the Yakima City Council, do hereby proclaim that we celebrate the Yakima Rotary Club and the accomplishments and contributions it has made to improve the lives of our Yakima community members and the world, by proclaiming December as
