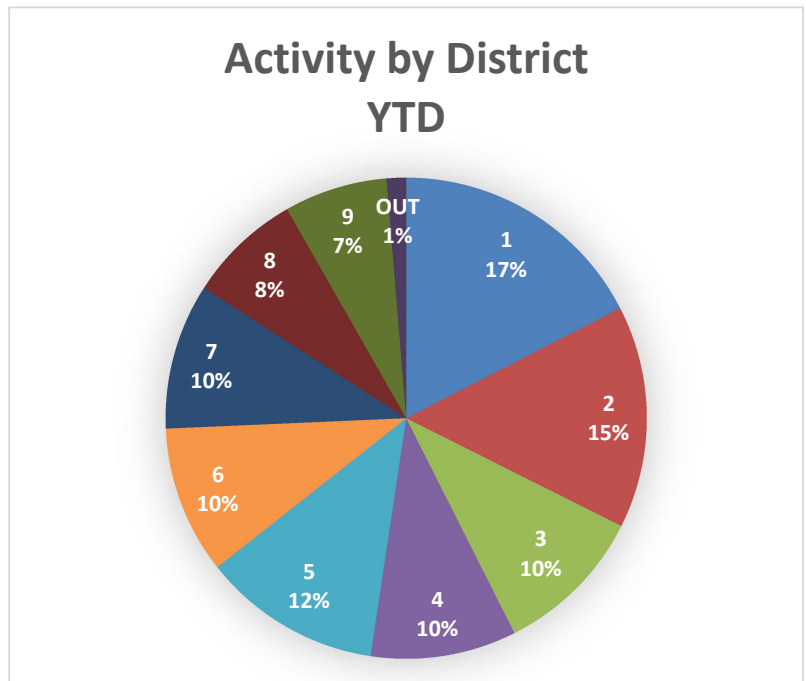

Subject: District Officer report

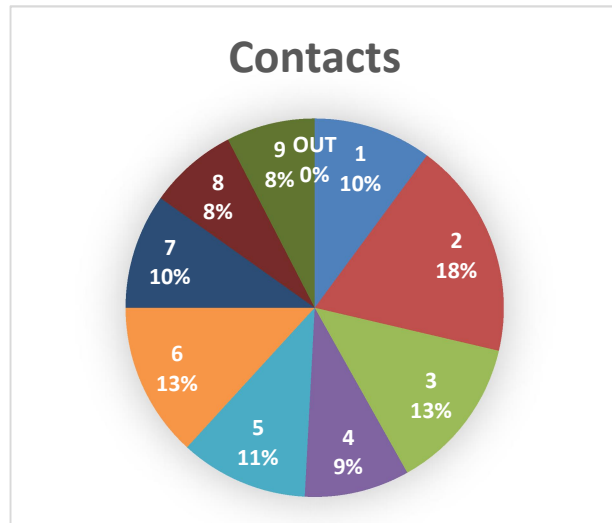
