

Bird Rides, Inc. is formally expressing interest in operating within the City of Yakima, Washington. We seek to express our desire to launch, with the support of the city, 100 to 150 shared scooters within the city for use by residents and visitors.

Bird works closely with local government agencies to bring convenient, sustainable transit to communities with stand-up electric scooters designed to be rented for short trips using the Bird Mobile App. Our overarching mission is get people out of cars, reduce traffic and bring communities together by providing an affordable, environmentally-friendly transit alternative.

Birds goals and commitments are as follows:

- 1. **Support Transportation Mode Shift** Alleviate automobile/car traffic and congestion in cities and regions across the globe by replacing short car trips with micromobility options
- 2. Enhance Transit and First Last Mile Connectivity Bird has a demonstrated ability to work in connection with existing local public transportation services/providers (buses, trains, light rail and other modes) by helping residents access public transit while integrating shared EVs (ie, scooters) for last mile connectivity.
- **3. Support Infrastructure Investments** Integrate micromobility business models into local/regional planning and implementation efforts across housing, community development, and transportation.
- 4. **Encourage Local Innovation** Promote safety, active transportation, carbon emission goals, ADA access, and other city goals.
- 5. **Rider Engagement and Education** Educating riders on safety is core to our service, and key to successful local implementation.
