

RESOLUTION NO. R-2021-__

A RESOLUTION authorizing an agreement with HDR Engineering to provide design amendments and construction services for the Nelson Dam Removal, Water Supply, Riverine Process and Fish Passage project.

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima is in the process of replacing Nelson Dam, and

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2015 the City entered into a contract with HDR Engineering to evaluate alternatives for Nelson Dam, which included a task to do engineering design, bidding, and construction services as determined in the Alternatives Analysis, and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2019 the City entered into an Interlocal Agreement with Yakima County to share expenses and construction oversight, and

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima Irrigation System and Nelson Dam have undergone several studies about replacement and fish screening facilities and the existing dam requires replacement and improvements to serve the irrigation system and allow for fish passage, and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2019 the City entered into a contract with HDR Engineering to design the Nelson Dam Removal, Water Supply, Riverine Process and Fish Passage project, which included a task to do construction services which was authorized by R-2019-055 and has been completed, and

WHEREAS, a contract for the construction for the Nelson Dam Removal, Water Supply, Riverine Process and Fish Passage project was been authorized on July 6, 2021 by Resolution R-2021-092, and

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima Water/Irrigation Division desires some amendments and construction services for the Nelson Dam Removal, Water Supply, Riverine Process and Fish Passage project as identified in the design contract with HDR Engineering, and

WHEREAS, due to HDR's knowledge of the structure and the project it is prudent, efficient and most cost-effective, and therefore in the best interest of the City and its residents, to continue to use them as the engineer for this project; and

WHEREAS, the Scope of Work and Budget included in this agreement meet the needs and requirements of the City of Yakima for this project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Yakima find that entering into the engineering contract with HDR is in the best interest of the City and its residents; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Professional Services Agreement between the City of Yakima and HDR Engineering, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, not to exceed \$1,665,000 to provide the Professional Services as described in the Agreement.
