A RESOLUTION authorizing the City Manager to execute the Supplemental Professional Services Agreement with Gray & Osborne, Inc. to provide engineering services for the 1st Level Reservoir Repairs, Improvements and Services.

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima (City) maintains water distribution and storage systems in accordance with applicable Federal, State and Local regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City's Water/Irrigation Division requires engineering services for 1st Level Reservoir Repairs, Improvements and services during construction; and

WHEREAS, the City's Water/Irrigation Division representatives have complied with the provisions of RCW 39.80 regarding the procurement of engineering and architectural services by a city; and

WHEREAS, in September, 2020, the City evaluated qualification submittals from two Engineering firms, and on September 16, 2020, the City held interviews with those Engineering firms; and

WHEREAS, as a result of these interviews, the City selected Gray and Osborne, Inc. as the most qualified engineering firm to perform the required work; and

WHEREAS, the 1st Level Reservoir is leaking and has structural issues that need to be repaired: and

WHEREAS, it was anticipated in the original agreement and scope of work that the Professional Services Agreement would be supplemented after it was determined the scope of work regarding construction and repair of the leakage and structural issues; and

WHEREAS, the initial inspection and evaluation of the reservoir through contract 2020-204 resulted in the determination of the necessary work to repair the reservoir, which is outlined in the attached supplement agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Yakima and its residents to enter into the Supplemental Professional Services Agreement with Gray & Osborne, Inc., to perform the required engineering services for the 1st Level Reservoir Repairs and Improvements Project; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute Supplemental Professional Services Agreement with Gray & Osborne, Inc., attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, not to exceed Two Hundred Sixteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$216,500) to provide engineering services for the 1st Level Reservoir Repairs, Improvements and Services During Construction Project.
