

RESOLUTION NO. R-2021-

A RESOLUTION authorizing a collective bargaining agreement for 2022-2026 with the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME) Local 1122 representing the Municipal employee bargaining unit.

WHEREAS, pursuant to requirements of state law, labor negotiations have occurred between the City and Municipal Employees represented by the AFSCME Local 1122 resulting in the attached proposed collective bargaining agreement for 2022 through 2026; and

WHEREAS, the AFSCME members have voted in favor of the attached proposed collective bargaining agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Yakima to settle collective bargaining in accordance with the terms and conditions of the attached collective bargaining agreement, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The City Manager of the City of Yakima is hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached and incorporated Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Yakima and AFSCME Municipal employees. The City Manager is also hereby authorized to and, without a further resolution, execute amendments to the collective bargaining agreement which may be necessary or appropriate to clarify its terms and conditions, maintain compliance the law, and/or make other minor adjustments.
