## ORDINANCE NO. 2021-

**AN ORDINANCE** fixing and levying the amount of ad valorem taxes necessary to discharge the expected expenses and obligations for the 2022 Budget for the City of Yakima.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the total net amount of \$20,712,107 in revenue must be raised by ad valorem taxes on real and personal property within the corporate limits of the City of Yakima to discharge the expected expenses and obligations for the 2022 Budget for the City of Yakima; and

WHEREAS, property tax is a tax based on ownership of a piece of real estate. A "levied property tax" is generally a tax imposed on property owners, based on the value of their property and the municipal government's needs, now therefore,

## **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF YAKIMA:**

<u>Section 1</u>. There is hereby fixed to be raised by general property taxes upon real and personal property within the City of Yakima the amount of \$20,712,107 for the following purposes:

(1) Includes an additional \$100,000 to provide for final adjustments in State assessed, refunds, new construction, and annexation values.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City Clerk is directed to transmit and file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Board of Yakima County Commissioners and the Yakima County Assessor on or before November 30, 2021.

<u>Section 3.</u> Pursuant to Article VI, Section 2 of the Yakima City Charter, this ordinance shall take effect on November 16, 2021.
