

RESOLUTION NO. R-2022-

A RESOLUTION amending the adopted Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the period of 2023 through 2028 and amending the Transportation Systems Plan 2040.

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2022 the City of Yakima (City) adopted R-2022-069 as required by state statute to update its Six-year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and the Transportation Systems Plan 2040; and

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima desires to amend the adopted Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program and the Transportation Systems Plan 2040 with the following four additional projects:

- S. 1st St/Russell Lane I/S Improvements
- 3rd Ave /Division St I/S Improvements
- East Yakima Sidewalk Improvements
- Nob Hill Boulevard Resurfacing; and,

WHEREAS, after a public hearing on the matter, held at the regular meeting of the Yakima City Council on September 6, 2022, with proper public notice as required by RCW 35.77.010, the City Council amends the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for the period of 2023 through 2028 and the Transportation Systems Plan 2040; and,

WHEREAS, amending the Six-year Transportation Improvement Program and amending the Transportation Systems Plan 2040 are in the best interest of the City and its residents; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The amended Six-Year Construction Program for the period of 2023 through 2028, and Transportation Systems Plan 2040, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference made a part thereof, is hereby adopted and approved.
