

RESOLUTION NO. R-2022-

A RESOLUTION setting September 6th, 2022 to review and adopt the amended Six-year Transportation Improvement Program and amend the Capital Facilities Element of the Yakima Urban Area Comprehensive Plan for the period of 2023-2028.

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2022 the City of Yakima adopted a six-year program for the construction of streets and arterial streets in the City of Yakima for the ensuing six-year period, all as contemplated and required by the State RCW 35.77.010 and applicable federal law; and

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima desires to amend the six-year program to include four (4) additional projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima desires to amend the Yakima Urban Area Comprehensive Plan Capital Facilities Element to reflect the amended Six-year TIP, as contemplated and required by RCW 36.70A.070(6) to ensure compliance with the Growth Management Act and consistency of the Comprehensive Plan and the Six-year TIP; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing must be held on said programs before final approval, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

That said program shall be presented for hearing and determination on Tuesday, September 6th, 2022, at the hour of 6:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, or as soon thereafter as the same may be heard, and the notice of such hearing be given as approved by law.
