AN ORDINANCE

fixing and levying the amount of ad valorem taxes necessary to discharge the expected expenses and obligations for the 2023 Budget for the City of Yakima.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the total net amount of \$21,759,389 in revenue must be raised by ad valorem taxes on real and personal property within the corporate limits of the City of Yakima to discharge the expected expenses and obligations for the 2023 Budget for the City of Yakima, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

<u>Section 1</u>. There is hereby fixed to be raised by general property taxes upon real and personal property within the City of Yakima the amount of \$21,759,389 for the following purposes:

- <u>Section 2</u>. The City Clerk is directed to transmit and file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Board of Yakima County Commissioners and the Yakima County Assessor on or before November 30, 2022.
- <u>Section 3</u>. Pursuant to Article VI, Section 2 of the Yakima City Charter, this ordinance shall take effect on November 1, 2022.
