A RESOLUTION

authorizing a Grant Agreement with the US. Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration to provide funding assistance for two fixed-route transit buses.

WHEREAS, in 2022, the City of Yakima (City) will order two 35-foot low floor Gillig buses as part of Yakima Transit's capital vehicle replacement plan; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, the US. Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration (FTA) opened up a grant funding opportunity under Federal Transit Administration American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 program; and

WHEREAS, Yakima Transit applied for funding on June 27, 2022, and was awarded funding, on September 15, 2022 in the amount of \$1,100,000; and

WHEREAS, the two buses that will be ordered December of 2022 and will be delivered on or around March of 2024; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City and the FTA to enter into an agreement setting forth the terms, conditions, and requirements for allocating this funding; now; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into Grant Agreement WA-2022-063—01-00 with US. Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration to fund six fixed-route transit buses; is authorized to accept said grant funds to be applied to the purposes specified above; and is further authorized to complete any other forms necessary to procure the grant and/or grant funding.
