

RESOLUTION NO. R-2022-

A RESOLUTION approving the conditional settlement agreement entered into by the City of Yakima and Medstar, LLC, and Medstar Cabulance, Inc. to settle the claim brought against the City of Yakima by Medstar, LLC, and Medstar Cabulance, Inc.

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2017, a lawsuit was filed in Yakima County Superior Court Case No. 17-2-02335-39 entitled *Medstar, LLC, a Washington limited liability company, and assignee of the contract rights of Medstar Cabulance, Inc., a Washington corporation v. The City of Yakima, a municipal corporation*; and,

WHEREAS, through a mediation, settlement with plaintiffs, Medstar, LLC, and Medstar Cabulance, Inc., in the amount of \$210,000 was reached with the City of Yakima to resolve and conclude plaintiffs' claim in the matter; and,

WHEREAS, plaintiffs agreed to execute a Settlement and Release Agreement upon approval of the proposed settlement by the Yakima City Council; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Yakima deems it to be in the interest of the City to authorize the City Manager to consent to a settlement entered into by the City of Yakima and the plaintiffs to resolve and conclude plaintiffs' claim, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The City Manager of the City of Yakima is authorized to consent to the settlement entered into by the City of Yakima to resolve and settle the lawsuit brought by the above-named plaintiffs. The City Manager and/or the City's legal counsel are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to conclude settlement as consistent with this Resolution.
