### Occupancy Types

#### Group 1

- ${\bf B}$  (Business) The use of a building or structure for office, professional or service type transactions.
- R (Residential) The use of a building or structure for sleeping purposes. (Day Cares: in home childcare facilities caring for less than 12 children) (Care Facility: in home for five or fewer persons)
- U \_ (Miscellaneous) Buildings and structures of an accessory character and miscellaneous structures not classifed in any specific occupancy. (barn, carports, grain, silos, etc.)

#### Group 2

- A (Assembly) The use of a building or structure for the gathering of persons for the purposes such as civic, social or relgious functions, recreation, foor or drink consumption or awaiting transportation.
- ${f M}$  (Mercantile) Building or stuctures used for the display and sale of merchandise accessible to the public.
- E \_ (Educational) The use of a building or structure by 6 or more persons for educational purposes through the 12th grade. (Daycares: more than 5 children older than 2.5 years of age)
- I \_ (Institutional) The use of a building or structure in which people are cared for or are living in a supervised environment. This includes people having physical limitations because of health or age, are harbored for medical treatment or other.

#### Group 3

- The use of a building or structure for assemnling, disssembling, fabricating, finishing, manufacturing, packaging, repair or processing F ...
- $\boldsymbol{F}$   $_{\text{operation.}}$
- H (Hazardous) The use of a building or structure that involves the manufacturing, processing, generation or storage of materials that constitutes a physical health hazard.
- ${f S}$  \_ (Storage) The use of a building or structure for storage that is not classified as an "H" occupancy.

<sup>\*</sup>Inspections exceeding 2 personnel hours in duration to incur additional hourly rate of \$50/hour (charged in 30 minute increments) per inspector.

<sup>\*</sup>Vacant Occupancies, deduct \$25 from fee schedule. Vacant occupancies defined as containing no storage and are unoccupied at time of inspection.

<sup>\*</sup>A 3% inflarionary increase shall be applied to the fees listed above each year thereafter.
