**A RESOLUTION** authorizing a collective bargaining agreement with the Yakima Police Patrolman's Association (YPPA) for January 1, 2020 - December 31, 2023.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Washington State law, the City and Yakima Police Patrolman's Association (YPPA) have engaged in negotiations resulting in the attached collective bargaining agreement for Yakima Police Patrolman's Associations (YPPA) Group for January 1, 2020 - December 31, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the Yakima Police Patrolman's Association (YPPA) and City of Yakima negotiated in good faith to reach the proposed collective bargaining agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the bargaining unit has voted on and approved the attached proposed collective bargaining agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Yakima to agree to the terms and conditions of the attached collective bargaining agreement for January 1, 2020 - December 31, 2023, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:**

The City Manager of the City of Yakima is hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached and incorporated collective bargaining agreement between the City of Yakima and the Yakima Police Patrolman's Association (YPPA). The City Manager is also hereby authorized to and, without a further resolution, execute amendments to the collective bargaining agreement which may be necessary or appropriate to clarify its terms and conditions, maintain compliance the law, and/or make other minor adjustments.
