authorizing and directing the City Manager of the City of Yakima to enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with the State of Arizona Procurement Office

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima (City), desires to arrange for making cooperative purchases of certain goods and services with the State of Arizona Procurement Office; and the City Council of the City of Yakima deems it to be in the best interests of the City that such arrangement be carried out; and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of RCW 39.34, the City of Yakima may enter into intergovernmental cooperative purchasing agreements with other public agencies in order to allow the parties of said agreements to cooperatively purchase or acquire supplies, equipment, and materials under contract and to utilize each other's contracts, as needs arise; and,

WHEREAS, it is recommended to City Council that the City of Yakima enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with the State of Arizona Procurement Office to allow the City to utilize prices negotiated by the State of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Yakima finds that it is in the best interests of the City and its residents to enter into the agreement for cooperative purchasing; now, therefore.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Intergovernmental Purchasing Agreement with the State of Arizona Procurement Office for the purpose mentioned above.
