**A RESOLUTION** authorizing a Contract with Insituform Technologies, LLC. for Project SC2560 Cured-In-Place Pipe Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewer Mains

**WHEREAS**, the City of Yakima (City) maintains the Wastewater Collections System in accordance with applicable Federal, State and Local regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Wastewater Division has identified pipeline segments that require rehabilitation or replacement; and

WHEREAS, this and future projects will stabilize current conditions of the City's wastewater pipe system and reduce infiltration of groundwater which will save treatment costs, improve collection system reliability, and limit the need for upgrades to the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution R-2020-034, the City entered into an Agreement with HLA Engineering and Surveying (HLA) to prepare the plans and contract documents for the rehabilitation of City's sanitary sewer main lines in various locations within the City, and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Wastewater Division requires construction services for the rehabilitation of approximately 18,000 linear feet of deficient collections system pipes; and

**WHEREAS**, The City used the procedure established by the State of Washington for competitively bidding projects; and

**WHEREAS**, Insituform, Inc. submitted the low bid and has the ability to perform the contact specified work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Yakima and its residents to enter into a Contract with Insituform Technologies, LLC. to perform the work detailed in the contract documents for the rehabilitation of approximately 18,000 linear feet of aging City sanitary sewer main lines by means of cured-in-place pipe; now, therefore

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the attached Contract with Insituform Technologies, LLC., in the amount of ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,431,300), for the rehabilitation of approximately 18,000 linear feet of aging City of Yakima sanitary sewer main lines by means of cured-in-place pipe in various locations within the City.
