

RESOLUTION NO. R-2022-_____

A RESOLUTION authorizing an Agreement with HLA Engineering and Land Surveying, Inc. to provide Professional Construction Management, Observation and Administration Services for the Nob Hill Boulevard Resurfacing and Pacific Avenue Sidewalk Improvements Projects 2619 and 2612.

WHEREAS, the Nob Hill Boulevard Resurfacing project received \$1,335,000 from the Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) for design and construction with a minimum 20% local match required; and

WHEREAS, the Pacific Avenue Sidewalk Improvements project received \$250,000 from TIB for Complete Streets requiring no local match; and

WHEREAS, the Nob Hill Boulevard Resurfacing and Pacific Avenue Sidewalk Improvements projects will be combined into one construction project for ease of administration and reduced construction costs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima (City) has the need to perform construction management on the Nob Hill Boulevard Resurfacing and Pacific Avenue Sidewalk Improvements Projects; and

WHEREAS, the City used the procedure established by Washington State law for the bidding and awarding of public capital improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, HLA was determined to be qualified to perform the needed professional construction management work and was selected to provide professional construction management, observation and administration services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Yakima finds that entering into the Professional Services Agreement with HLA Engineering and Land Surveying, Inc., for construction management on the Nob Hill Boulevard Resurfacing and Pacific Avenue Sidewalk Improvements projects is in the best interests of the City and its residents; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Professional Services Agreement with HLA Engineering and Land Surveying, Inc., attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, not to exceed Two Hundred Thirty Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$230,900) to provide construction management services and services outlined in the Professional Services Agreement.
