Award – Yakima 2024 Northside Alley Paving**

Dear Mayor Deccio,

Congratulations! The 2022/2023 competitive process for the Yakima Valley Conference of Government's (YVCOG's) Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality (CMAQ) Funding Program is complete and the YVCOG Transportation Policy Board approved \$500,000 in CMAQ funds toward the City of Yakima's **2024 Northside Alley Paving Project** (construction phase).

Project progress reports will be required for all regional CMAQ funded projects as part of the monthly YVCOG Transportation Technical Advisory Committee meeting(s). Any changes in federal funding amounts or anticipated obligation dates must be reported as soon as possible.

The project can be entered into the City of Yakima's Transportation Improvement Program according to the following schedule:

- Obligation year = 2023; (2021-22 carryover, 2023) CMAQ funding = \$50,000 (PE Phase)
- Obligation year = 2024; CMAQ funding = \$450,000 (CN Phase)

Projects must be included in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) before these federal funds can be obligated. If you have any questions concerning STIP amendments, please contact Alan Adolf at YVCOG, (509) 574-1550 or email at alan.adolf@yvcog.org.
