

RESOLUTION NO. R-2024-

A RESOLUTION authorizing acceptance and execution of the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) Fuel Tax Grant Agreement for the Nob Hill Boulevard Grind & Overlay Project 2793.

WHEREAS, the Nob Hill Boulevard Grind & Overlay project includes milling and overlaying of roadway from S 4th Avenue to S 15th Avenue including ADA curb ramp improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima (City) was selected to receive up to 77.6217% reimbursement of eligible costs with a maximum grant of \$1,219,320 in state funding through the Fuel Tax Grant Agreement number 8-4-180(028)-1; and

WHEREAS, the City shall provide the remaining match and any additional funding from REET necessary to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interests of the City of Yakima and its residents to accept and execute the grant agreement with TIB for the Nob Hill Boulevard Grind & Overlay Project 2793, and authorize the City Manager to take all necessary steps to execute the grant agreement, necessary contracts, and administer the funds received from TIB; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the Washington State Department Transportation Improvement Board grant, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, not to exceed One Million Two Hundred Nineteen Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$1,219,320.00) as described in the Grant Program Agreement, and directed to take all necessary steps to secure the funding for the Nob Hill Boulevard Grind & Overlay Project 2793.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized by the TIB award.

Section 3. The City Manager, or his designee, shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to the award, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "1" and incorporated herein, and the budget submitted therewith for the TIB grant.

Section 4. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any and all contracts necessary and not to exceed the budgeted amounts outlined in Exhibit "1", and enter into any other necessary agreements or documents to accomplish the Nob Hill Boulevard Grind & Overlay Project 2793 funded through the award.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or clause of this resolution is declared invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of the resolution.
