

RESOLUTION NO. R-2024-

A RESOLUTION authorizing acceptance and execution of a grant program agreement with the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board Complete Streets for the Systemic Pedestrian Safety Improvements, City Project 2675

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima (City) is improving the functionality and safety of N 5th Avenue and West D Street Intersection; and

WHEREAS, improvements consist of constructing curb extensions, curb and gutter, new ADA curb ramps, upgrade signal controllers, and adjusting drainage; and

WHEREAS, the City previously accepted \$317,000 in Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funding (R-2023-002) for these improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima was selected to receive \$198,300 in funding through the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) Complete Streets, which requires no match for the project for these improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interests of the City of Yakima and its residents to accept and execute the grant agreement with TIB for the Systemic Pedestrian Safety Improvements Project 2675, and authorize the City Manager to take all necessary steps to execute the grant agreement, necessary contracts, and administer the funds received from TIB; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the TIB grant, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, not to exceed One Hundred, Ninety-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$198,000.00) as described in the Grant Award Letter and the City Manager is hereby authorized to take all necessary steps to execute the grant agreement, necessary contracts, and administer the funds received from the TIB grant.
