

RESOLUTION NO. R-2024-

A RESOLUTION authorizing an agreement with Interwest Construction, Inc. for the McClaren Street Vicinity Wastewater Improvements Project SC2783.

WHEREAS, the City of Yakima (City) maintains the Wastewater Collections System in accordance with applicable Federal, State and Local regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City's Wastewater Division has identified pipeline segments that require rehabilitation or replacement; and

WHEREAS, this and future projects will stabilize current conditions of the City's wastewater pipe system and reduce infiltration of groundwater which will save treatment costs, improve collection system reliability, and limit the need for upgrades to the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution R-2023-139, the City entered into an Agreement with HLA Engineering and Surveying (HLA) to prepare the plans and contract documents for the rehabilitation and replacement of City sanitary sewer main lines in various locations within the City, and

WHEREAS, the City's Wastewater Division requires construction services for the replacement of approximately 5,000 linear feet of collections system pipes and 14 sewer manholes in the vicinity of McClaren Street; and

WHEREAS, The City used the procedure established by the State of Washington for competitively bidding projects; and

WHEREAS, Interwest Construction, Inc. submitted the low bid and has the ability to perform the contact specified work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Yakima and its residents to enter into a Contract with Interwest Construction, Inc. to perform the work detailed in the contract documents; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAKIMA:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the attached Contract with Interwest Construction, Inc., in the amount of TWO MILLION ONE HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE DOLLARS AND FIFTY-NINE CENTS (\$2,144,869.59), for the replacement of approximately 5,000 linear feet of City sanitary sewer main lines and 14 sewer manholes in the vicinity of McClaren Street.
